All Leagues – Football & Hurling

- League matches may be played with a minimum of 13 players and unlimited substitutions shall be allowed throughout the game. Please note:
 - If both clubs have 15 players toggled they must play 14 a side.
 - If both clubs have 16 or more players toggled out they must play 15 a side.
 - If additional players arrive after the start of the game the numbers may be increased by agreement up to a maximum of 15 a-side.
- Where a club is fielding two teams in the league a list of all their players, who are graded in the highest grade for Championship, shall be listed on one side of a sheet and 17 players from that list shall be named and they may only assist the team in the higher grade of the league. The remaining players may play in the higher and lower grades in the league. The list/s of players shall be submitted to the Competitions Control Committee Secretary, not less than ten days prior to a club's first league fixture.
- League games shall be played at the venue of the first named team. Where the home venue is unplayable, the game shall be played at the venue of the away team. Finals shall be played at neutral venues, where possible. Extra time to be played in all Play-Offs, Semi-Finals & Finals, if necessary.
- Club league games shall be played in accordance with fixtures. A postponement may only be granted by the Competitions Control Committee following a written application from the Cathaoirleach or Runaí of the Club requesting the postponement and for the following grounds:
 - Death of Father, Mother, Brother, Sister, Wife, Child, or Grandparent of a player.
 - Death of a Club President, Officer (Eight Elected Officers as defined in 7.2 of the 2019 Club Constitution 7.2) or Clergyman.
 - Exceptional circumstances, at the discretion of the Competitions Control Committee.
 - Games postponed for the above reasons will be re-fixed for a date not later than 4 days of the Original fixture.
- Requests to bring a fixture forward or a time change, must have the agreement of both clubs and will only be accepted for consideration by email, before 12.00 noon on the Monday before the fixture is scheduled to be played. Exception: request for postponement in accordance with Co. Board Regulation No. 20. All league games to be played as per Master Fixtures Plan.
- A team failing to fulfill a fixture, in the underage Leagues, shall be fined €100 and the game awarded to their opponents. Teams withdrawing from a league competition shall be fined €100 for each game left to play, it's played games shall stand and un-played games awarded to the remaining teams. County players shall be available for all league finals & agreed rounds with CCC
- Clubs shall not be given permission to participate in Leinster Club leagues, if they refuse to partake in Offaly club leagues.
- Where teams finish with equal points for qualification for the Concluding Stages, or for Promotion or Relegation, the tie shall be decided by the following means and in the order specified:
 - Where two Teams only are involved - the outcome of the meeting of the two Teams in the previous game in the Competition;
 - Scoring Difference (subtracting the total Scores Against from total Scores for);
 - Highest Total Score for;
 - A Play-Off.

Note: In U13 and U15 leagues (b) & (c) above will only apply to the games concerning the teams who have finished level on points (where three or more teams finish level).

2020 league finals U13/U15/U17: Football only final (Top 2 teams from group), Hurling only final (Top two teams from group). Dual Football Final (Top team from each group 2/3). Dual Hurling Final (Top team from each group 2/3).
