

CLDP – ONLINE REGISTRATION GUIDE

THE IDEA IN BRIEF

The National Officer Development Committee, in conjunction with the GAA, LGFA and Camogie Association have combined to streamline Club Officer training from 2020 onwards. The Club Leadership Development Programme provides learning opportunities to new and existing Club Officers to help them gain the knowledge and skills necessary to fill their roles.

As part of the rollout of the new framework, it is hoped that online registration will become the norm going forward. This will allow for the development of –

- A certified pathway for new Club Officers via the Club Officer Foundation Award
- Easy and quick access to a suite of online supports and resources
- More consistent event organisation
- The ability to track progress
- Increased access to online and webinar-based learning

HOW IT WORKS

We are asking all participants in CLDP courses in 2020 and beyond to, firstly, create an account on the GAA Learning Portal - <https://learning.gaa.ie/>. A step-by-step guide is available via the Officer Development Coordinator – eoghan.tuohey@gaa.ie, if required. Participants will be asked to complete their online profile, which will then act as their central online hub for tracking their learning progress, browsing the calendar for more events and accessing online resources. They can also access online modules and live webinars.

NEXT STEPS

Once the participant has a Learning Portal account set up, they can register in advance for modules. Courses can be accessed by browsing the calendar and clicking on the preferred module - [Officer Training Calendar](#), or by using this link, [Club Leadership Development Programme County by County](#) which brings the user directly to the events being held in their county.

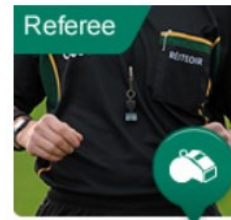
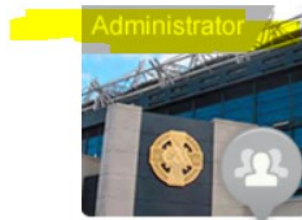
REGISTER FOR AN EVENT

Once the user has accessed their County's CLDP page, they click on the "Select your Modules" button toward the top of the page, then click "Save my choices" to register. The Programme Coordinator will follow up before the event if there are any changes in advance.
